SUMMARY SCHEDULE

Generally, sessions begin at 2 p.m. on Thursday afternoon and run until 6 p.m. Saturday (with plenty of breaks, of course). The Exhibit Hall opens immediately after the Keynote on Thursday evening and stays open for the rest of the event.

Teachers and Speakers

Teach Them Diligently is known for its fantastic speaking lineup. Every hour there will be more sessions available to you than time allows you to attend! There are typically more than 150 sessions at each Teach Them Diligently event. We load the schedule with amazing sessions because we want to offer as much value to your family as possible. Approximately 4 to 8 weeks before the event begins we will release a copy of the speaking schedule. You do not need to sign-up for sessions, but these early schedules will help you plan your days. Keep your heart open because we often find that the Lord re-directs plans once you arrive on-site. Families end up attending sessions they didn't originally plan to attend—but receive enormous blessing! Some couples even decide to split up and to maximize their time and share notes later. WHAT TO WEAR?

A lot of folks ask us what to wear at Teach Them Diligently. We recommend modest, casual wear. It's a good idea to wear layers as temperatures can vary from room to room. And comfy shoes are a must!

Be aware that sometimes the early schedule will change right before we get to the convention (to accommodate the travel needs of speakers) so you will want to double-check the schedule before and throughout the event. We have a smart phone app available as well where we post the most up-to-date information, so you'll want to download that before you come. Also, most sessions are recorded so that you don't have to miss a thing!

Connection

One of the most wonderful parts of our live events are the people. The camaraderie that you'll experience while at Teach Them Diligently Convention is like no other. Hundreds of like-minded families sharing the same space, singing together, praying together, learning and growing together—all with our children and family in mind, and with our focus on the Gospel. Checking-In

We utilize a digital QR or barcode check-in system where you can use your smart phone, or printed sheet of paper to quickly scan in and get your materials. Your packet will contain all the information you need for your specific family registration. You'll get a tote bag full of goodies, a printed program with a list of speaking sessions, a list of vendors, a map of the Exhibit Hall, and a map to help you navigate the facility. Our friendly staff will be happy to answer any of your questions. Plan to join us there!

There is also a grand opening party in the Exhibit Hall on Thursday immediately following the keynote! Some exhibitors will offer special deals available for that evening only. The companies represented in the Exhibit Hall are primarily small family businesses that pour their lives into offering support to the homeschool community. Please take the time to support them! Teach Them Diligently App

You can download our Teach Them Diligently app from iTunes or from Google.play. It's great for setting alarms and navigating the speaking sessions, finding your way around the venue, and Exhibit Hall, and it always contains the most up-to-date information. It also allows you to connect with other families, rate speakers, and share your experiences. You can use the QR code function on the app to connect with Exhibitors and get great deals and followup information. More content will be published to the apps as we get closer to the events, and we will send you an email when it's updated and ready to go for our 2020 season.

Audio Recordings

The Resounding Voice booth will typically be located in the lobby where you can purchase CDs or MP3 recordings from this year's convention. We recommend that you take notes during the event and mark the sessions you want to buy throughout the weekend so you don't forget! Many people will purchase the full set so they can re-listen to their favorite sessions and hear the ones they missed! It can take a lot of stress off having to choose which sessions to attend every hour!

HOMESCHOOL GUIDANCE COUNSELOR/COLLEGE FAIR

Families with 10th–12th grade students are invited to attend our Homeschool College Fair. When you bring your student and meet with our presenting University sponsors you will get a rebate off your family's registration! You'll have the opportunity for short one-on-one meetings with representatives from different schools. The colleges will present information specifically focused on homeschool enrollment and give you opportunity to get your college questions answered. Glean as much information as you can—not just about the individual schools, but about standardized testing, financial aid, dual credit, and directing your son or daughter into the next stages of life.



MOM'S NIGHT

Moms are invited join us on Friday night for fun, fellowship, laughter, relaxation, prayer, and much more! This evening is for MOMS ONLY! Dads will need to plan to get the children in bed, so mom can enjoy a night of fellowship and encouragement—you'll be glad you did! It's free to attend but be sure to register!



MEN'S BREAKFAST

Men are invited to join us as we break bread (and bacon!) together, on Saturday morning. This time will be dedicated to sharpening and encouraging one another as we discuss God's Word and plan for our families. The men's breakfast is available for both men and their sons. The price for the Men's Breakfast is: \$12. For Session only (no food) is \$5.



CHILDREN'S PROGRAM

Children ages 4–12 (all children need to be fully potty-trained) are invited to attend The Children's Program which runs Friday and Saturday from 9 a.m. until 6 p.m. with a break for lunch (on Thursday, children will attend sessions with their families). Due to allergy concerns, children are not permitted to bring snacks. However, you may check your child out to give him/her a snack at any time. Children will be picked up from the program to eat lunch with their families, and then be dropped off again during the posted drop-off times. The price for the Children's Program is: \$50–\$60 per child. Multi-Child discounts available during registration.



TEEN'S PROGRAM

This year's teen program will be themed, Generation of Change, and will encourage your teens in their walk with God! Teen sessions and meals are scheduled at the same times as the adult sessions and meals. Teens do not need to be checked in and/or out of the Teen Program. The price for the Teen's Program is: \$5 per young person.

Each of the venues chosen for Teach Them Diligently 2020 offer incredible accommodations to make your convention experience even better. The greatest advantage to staying on-site may be reduced food expenses. This is, in fact, a big reason we chose venues with connecting hotels. Typically, convention centers will not allow food into their buildings, but they will not stop families from bringing food into their hotel room.

TICKETS, REGISTRATION, AND CHECK-IN

The cost of Family Registration at each site includes all of the keynote and featured speaking sessions (nearly 150), access to the Exhibit Hall for all three days, plus a special tote bag filled with information, swag and specials from exhibitors. We also sell single-person registrations for the entire convention, or single-day passes for the family. We do NOT sell Exhibit Hall only passes.

Family Registrations can be shared with Grandparents, but not with a friend or family member from another household. Each friend or family member from another household most have their own registration.

The Children's Program, Teen's Program, and Men's Breakfast are offered at an additional charge. Any sessions not included in the Family Registration fee will be marked in the descriptions.

We try to ensure that our venues are littles-friendly. Bringing a stroller is always a good idea. While the convention center is divided into two levels there are elevators available

CHILDREN IN SPEAKING SESSIONS

You are welcome to bring your children into the speaking sessions; however, we do ask that you be considerate of others by having your children sit on the floor when possible, so adults can take the seats. Our goal is to be as family-friendly as possible, and we do not want parents to miss any sessions.

NURSING MOTHERS

The Registration Desk has a private room behind the check-in desk that nursing mothers are welcome to use if they prefer privacy. The restrooms in the Embassy are also spacious and very clean. And we do not discourage nursing mothers from modestly breastfeeding in open areas either.

We will send out regular email communications to keep you informed about new speakers, exhibitors, and other exciting pieces of convention news!
