

True Love Bible Search & Sort

The world's definition of true love and God's definition are very different. Ask your child to search God's Word for His definition of true love by reading the passages included on the top of page 3. Then cut out, read and sort the definitions of love also on page 3. Students could also glue down once they are sorted.

This activity was designed as independent work for 2nd grade and up, but could be used as an activity *with* your child if he is younger or needs extra help.

Quick Tip: Before setting your child "free" to use this activity independently, you may want to introduce the meaning of various vocabulary words and terms such as *sacrificial*, *unconditional*, or *boastful*.

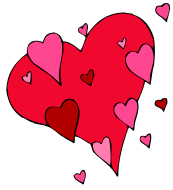


God's Definition of Love

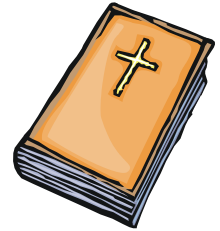
