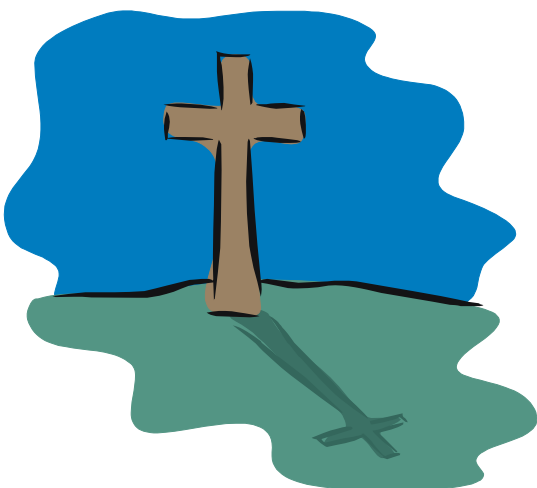


At the Cross

Final Word Pattern Sort

- Cut apart all words.
- Remove the -ss, -ff, and -ll cards from the stack.
- Read through all the cards to make sure the child knows how to read each word as well as each of the word meanings.
- Place the -ss, -ff, -ll cards at the top of your workspace.
- Ask the child to sort each word by their final pattern (either -ss, -ff, or -ll).
- See if the child can think of any other words that would fit into these patterns. Can he find more words in his reading?
- Are there any other consonant patterns that double at the end like this? (for example -zz or -ck)
