### SUMMARY SCHEDULE

## Teachers and Speakers

Teach Them Diligently is known for its fantastic speaking lineup. Every hour there will be more sessions available to you than time allows you to attend! Also, most sessions are recorded so that you don't have to miss a thing!

## Covid Considerations and Live Stream Information


This year, the facilities hosting Teach Them Diligently events will be requiring masks to be worn indoors for all attendees. They are following the guidelines laid out by their local governments, and we ask you to be diligent in honoring those. None of us like to be put in a situation where we have to ask someone to do something that's regulated, and we're sure that our hosts would really not like to do that either. We ask you to think about it as a matter of hospitality. These venues are inviting us in and they are committed to doing everything they can to make sure that we have a great time while we're there. So, for the privilege of getting together again and enjoying the fellowship that entails, we need to be diligent in following their rules. This provides us all an amazing opportunity to show God's love to them as we gather together as brothers and sisters in Christ and show them all how grateful we are that they are allowing us to do so in their facility. We are truly blessed and grateful that God has opened the door for us to gather this season, and we want to steward that opportunity very wisely.

The number of chairs in each room will be greatly diminished to allow for social distancing at the event. We're hoping to lay out the speaking rooms as intimately as possible despite the social distanced seating, and we're excited to see how even the re-imagined speaking rooms work this season. So many new, fun things to experience!

The Rogers Convention Center is being very diligent in keeping their facilities clean and safe, so we feel confident that you can come without concern of spread. If, though, health or other considerations keep you at home this season, we do plan to live stream our Nashville event. The schedule for that event is on the website, so you are welcome to request to transfer your Rogers ticket to a live stream pass if you like. That's another area we get to reimagine, and we're planning to use our app to include a lot behind the scenes, excluding content that will stream directly into the app. Again, everything is in motion, but we're still working on the details.

### WHAT TO WEAR?

A lot of folks ask us what to wear at Teach Them Diligently. We recommend modest, casual wear. It's a good idea to wear layers as temperatures can vary from room to room. And comfy shoes are a must!



## Checking-In

When you get to Teach Them Diligently this year, we'll have several hosts available to help you navigate the check in process as it may look different than it has in years past. ### **HOMESCHOOL GUIDANCE COUNSELOR/COLLEGE FAIR**

Families with a 10th, 11th, or 12th grade students are invited to attend our Homeschool College Fair. Each family will have the opportunity for a short one-on-one meeting with representatives from different schools. In these meetings, the colleges will present information specifically focused on homeschool enrollment, ask you questions about your young person, and give you an opportunity to get your college questions answered. Glean as much information as you can—not just about the individual schools, but about standardized testing, financial aid, grades, dual credit, and directing your son or daughter into the next stages of life. It's way easier than scheduling and traveling for college visits, especially in this COVID year.



### **MOM'S NIGHT**

Moms are invited to join us on Friday night for fun, fellowship, games, laughter, relaxation, prayer, and much, much more! This evening is for MOMS ONLY! Dads will need to plan to get the children in bed, so mom can enjoy a night of fellowship and encouragement—you will be really glad you did! It's free to attend but be sure to register!



### **MEN'S BREAKFAST**

Men are invited to join us as we break bread (and bacon!) together, on Saturday morning. This time will be dedicated to sharpening and encouraging one another as we discuss God's Word and plan for our families. The men's breakfast is available for both men and their sons. The price for the Men's Breakfast is: \$12. For Session only (no food) is \$5. Again, specific details about this program will be more readily available as we get closer to the convention.



### **CHILDREN'S PROGRAM**

Children between the ages of 4 and 12 (grades K4–6th) are allowed to attend (all children need to be fully potty-trained). The Children's Program runs Friday and Saturday from 9 a.m. until roughly 6 p.m., with a break for lunch (on Thursday, children will attend sessions with their families). Due to allergy concerns, children are not permitted to bring snacks with them. However, you may check your child out to give him/her a snack. Children will be picked up from the program to eat lunch with their families, and then be dropped off again during the drop-off times. The price for the Children's Program is: \$55 per child. Please bear in mind that the mask ordinance in place in Rogers will apply to children in the children's program that are **10 years and older**.



### **TEEN'S PROGRAM**

This year's teen program will encourage your teens in their walk with God! Teen sessions and meals are scheduled at the same times as the adult sessions and meals. Teens do not need to be checked in and/or out of the Teen Program. The price for the Teen's Program is: \$5 per young person.

Each of the venues chosen for Teach Them Diligently 2021 offer incredible accommodations to make your convention experience even better. The greatest advantage to staying on-site may be reduced food expenses. This is, in fact, a big reason we chose venues with connecting hotels. Typically, convention centers will not allow food into their buildings, but they will not stop families from bringing food into their hotel room.
